Welcome to Australia. You will be met on arrival by our Representative, fast-tracked through Immigration, assisted with baggage collection, fast-tracked through Customs and Quarantine and escorted to your limousine waiting kerbside for the transfer to your domestic flight.

Depart on a flight from Sydney to Hamilton island. (not included in costs)

Sydney Sightseeing - BridgeClimb Sydney

Day BridgeClimb

Please check in 15 minutes prior to the specified climb time. You are required to take a breath test. If test reading is 0.05% or greater you will not be permitted to Climb.

The original climbing adventure of the bridge, takes Climbers to the top of the bridge's structure for a 3½ hour experience of Sydney and its magnificent harbour.

Climbing during the day with the city buzzing around you has an energetic, vibrant feel. Standing on top of the Bridge in the centre of Sydney Harbour, take in the sights of the Sydney foreshore and the World Heritage listed Sydney Opera House. As the sounds of the city, trains and traffic filter up from below, a clear day will afford you views that stretch from the Pacific Ocean to the Blue Mountains. Climb Leaders will point out key landmarks that can be seen from the top of this great icon.

Please note: no cameras, mobile phones or other personal belongings can be taken on the climb. These can be stored at the BridgeClimb office.

Sydney Sightseeing - AEA Luxury Tours

Blue Mountains Deluxe Eco Day

The Blue Mountains Deluxe Day is a real journey into the heart of a unique World Heritage Region. From temperate rainforests to towering sandstone escarpments, you'll see and experience it all. Join us, let the landscape work its wonders and become part of you for a lifetime.

Your informative and knowledgeable guide will collect you from your Sydney hotel as we commence our small group deluxe tour into the heart of the unique Blue Mountains World Heritage Region. The Blue Mountains National Park is one of seven national parks that make up the Greater Blue Mountains World Heritage Area. This wonderland of sandstone outcrops, deep ravines and hazy blue eucalypt forests boasts luxury retreats and the world's steepest railway. Today your guide will take you off the beaten track to visit remote lookout locations and discuss the history, flora and fauna of this magnificent region.

Our first stop this morning is at Featherdale Wildlife Park where we arrive before any other tourists to meet the native Australian animals here – guests can actually get up close and personal, stroke a koala and hand feed kangaroos, wallabies & emus...a great experience.

Departing from Featherdale, we commence our drive to the Blue Mountains via the highway. We will travel through the picturesque village of Wentworth Falls, home to a good collection of Victorian and other historic buildings and onto the Wentworth Falls Lookout. With spectacular views over the Jamison Valley and the magnificent waterfall for which it is named, this beautiful lookout is our first stop. Here we enjoy a leisurely 30 minute round trip walk to see the Waterfalls.

Continuing on we arrive at Eaglehawk Lookout, a remote lookout point away from the crowds for views of the famous 3 Sisters. Whilst the Blue Mountains features so much more than this natural attraction you can't help but admire the unquestionable beauty of this amazing rock formation. The character of the Three Sisters changes throughout the day and throughout the seasons as the sunlight brings out the magnificent colours. Here your guide will discuss the legends behind this famous rock formation and time available for you to take some great photos.

We then make our way around the mountain to the village of Blackheath and our lunch venue the Blackheath Golf Club. Here in this relaxed, friendly club we enjoy a 2 course lunch food only.

All diets are catered for. Beverages can be purchased at your own expense from the Bar.

The afternoon is spent visiting a selection of lookouts. Once you clap your eyes on the view from Govetts Leap you'll know why it's one of the most famous lookouts in Australia. The magnificent waterfall drops a whopping 180m to the base of the cliff. If you're not mesmerised by the dancing waves of water spray, you'll be transfixed by the sweeping views down the valley to the Grose Wilderness. We then drive through the picturesque village of Mt Wilson and stop to enjoy a glass of sparkling wine or orange juice at a beautiful remote lookout location. The last stop is at the delightful Mt Tomah Botanic Gardens where we stop to enjoy the sweeping views across to Sydney before travelling down the Bells Line of Road to arrive back at your hotel approximately 4.30 - 5.00pm.

SEIT Uluru Highlights – early morning

Inclusions: Pickup and return to Ayers Rock Resort, Uluru Park Fees, Guided walking tour, Outback picnic breakfast and bottled water

You will travel towards Uluru its vast shape rises from the sand dunes in the early dawn light highlighting its presence in this country. Your guide will take you to a special location to watch the sun rise over this amazing monolith. You will learn the creation stories of Liru (poisonous snake) and Kuniya (python) and hear about the Mala people. After breakfast you will visit Mutitjulu Waterhole and then drive around the base of the Uluru before returning to the resort.

SEIT Kata Tjuta Domes - afternoon

Arriving at Walpa Gorge you will walk between the mighty conglomerate domes and hear how these 36 domes that make up Kata Tjuta have evolved over millions of years. Take time to listen to the wind (Walpa) far above and view the scale of the rock walls that surround you. The spirituality of this amazing location embraces everyone who ventures here. Your guide will return you to your hotel in time for those people joining the Sounds of Silence dinner.
